Band Saw Safety

Band Saw Safety

- Wear Safety Glasses
- Tuck In/Take Off/Roll Up/Tieback
- Ask Permission/Make sure a teacher or mentor is supervising you
- Set the guard an 1/8th inch above your work
- Keep your fingers at least 3-inches away from the blade
- Use a push stick if needed
- Use Relief Cuts to relieve pressure from the blade on rounded cuts
- Don't Force It
- If the blade jams or stops, turn off the saw and call your teacher over.
- Wait until the machine comes to a complete stop before you leave.

Clean up!!

- Wait until machine has stopped
- Use a brush, not your hand

Speed for the Grisley

- Make sure set to metal (that is what machine is setup for)
- Use the table on the machine.
- The harder the material the slower the speed.

Horizontal Band Saw

- Set Speed Control so it is parallel to floor
- Lift cutting unit
- Clamp material in place
- Speed Control clockwise until it stops.
- Then turn Speed Control counterclockwise until it reaches 7
- Start the machine with the blade no more than 2-inches above material
- Turn machine on turn Speed Control perpendicular to floor
- Machine will stop on its own Do not attempt to remove material until blade has come to a stop
